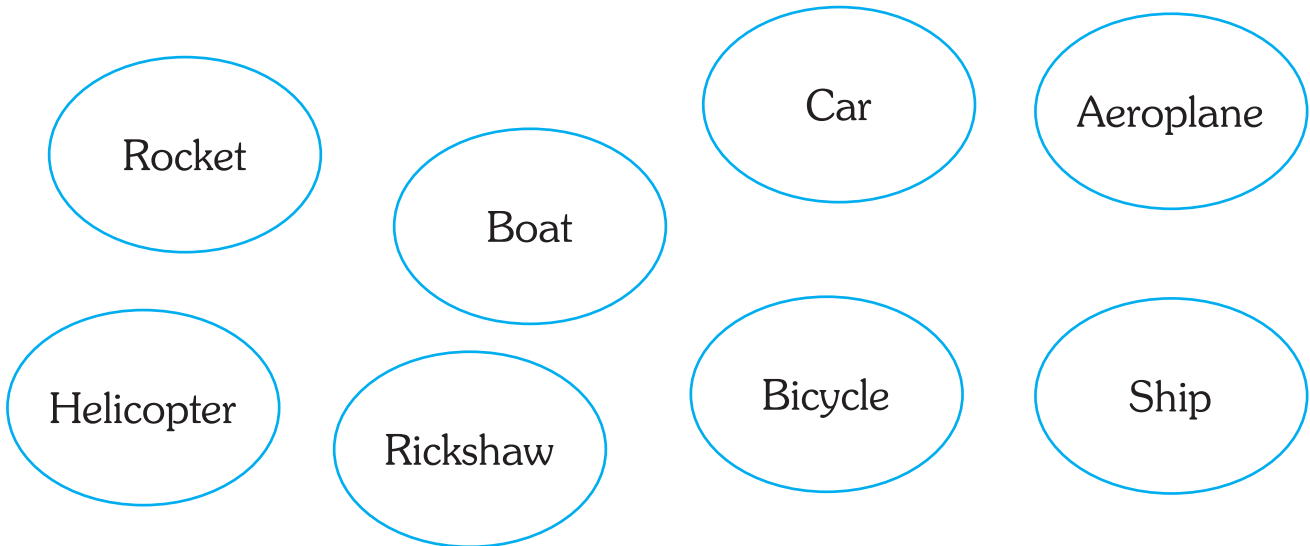

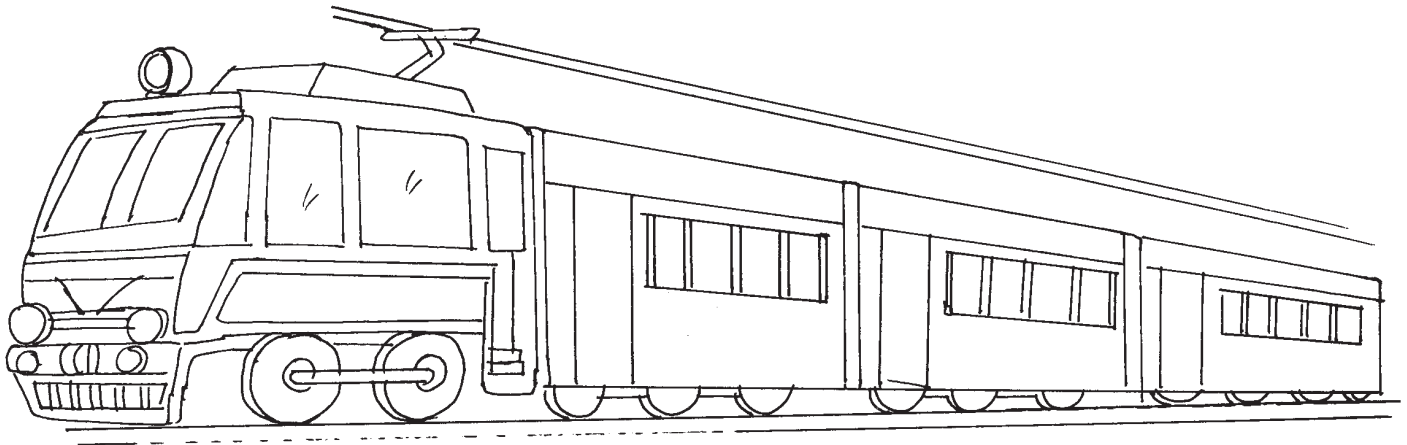
A. Vehicles are slow or fast moving.
