




Types Of Houses

Before we proceed

We need a place to live in. We build houses to protect us from heat, cold and rain. They protect us from thieves, enemies and animals too. We build houses according to the weather. We use building materials that are easily found in that area.



Huts are built with bamboos, mud and straw. These houses are not very strong. They are called *kachcha houses*. They are usually found in villages.



Some houses are built with bricks, iron and cement. They are called *pucca houses*. They are very strong. They are found in cities.

At some places we see multistorey buildings. A multistorey building has many houses one on the other. These houses are called *flats*.

There are other types of houses also.




This house floats on water. It is called *house-boat*.



This house moves on wheels. It is called a *caravan*.



This is a *tent*. It can be folded and carried along.



This is an *igloo*. It is made of ice. The Eskimos live in igloos.



This is a *stilt* house. It is built above the ground. Water and insects cannot get inside it easily.

Roofs of Houses

The roof is the topmost part of any building. In plains and dry areas, people build houses with flat roofs.






In hilly areas or in places where it rains or snows a lot, people make houses with sloping roofs.

A house with sloping roof


Building Materials

Animals too, use different materials to make their homes. Some animals find a nice place and make their home in it. Some others make their






A bird makes a *nest* to live in.




PROJECT/ACTIVITY

A. Make a house.

The things you will need are:

Chart paper (white and red), toothpicks/twigs, crayons, glue stick, scissors **Steps:**

- 1. Glue twigs or toothpicks on the white chart paper to make the wall of the cabin.
- 2. Use the red chart paper to cut a triangular roof for the cabin. Paste it on the paper.
- 3. Cut and paste a rectangular door and square windows.
- 4. Add a door knob, chimney, well, hills, sky, sun, etc.

- 2. Always eat food on dining table.
