All of us wear clothes. We wear clothes to cover our body. We look smart in clothes. Clothes protect us from heat, cold, rain, dirt, dust and insect-bites.

Kinds of clothes: We wear different clothes in different seasons and on different occasions.

In summer season, we wear cotton clothes in light shades. Cotton absorbs sweat and keeps us cool. We get cotton from the cotton plant. In winter season, we wear woollen clothes. Woollen clothes keep us warm.

Where do we get wool from?

In rainy season, we wear raincoats and gumboots. We use umbrellas. Umbrellas protect us from rains. They are made of plastic or rubber. They do not soak in water.

Uniform: Some people do special jobs. They wear special clothes. These clothes are called their uniform. We also wear uniform, when we go to school.

People in different countries wear different clothes. People of different states of our country also wear different types of clothes.





Raw materials for clothes:

Our clothes are made of different fibres like cotton fibre, woollen fibre, silk fibre and synthetic fibre.





Cotton fibre : We get cotton fibre from cotton plants. Cotton grows in pods. These pods are plucked and spun into threads. Then thread is woven into a cloth on a loom. Making cloth from thread is called weaving.







Wool: We get wool from sheep. Wool is the thick hair of a sheep. Wool is sheared from the body of the sheep; then cleaned and spun into threads. Then woollen clothes are woven or knitted with this thread.







Silk fibre: We get silk from silkworm. The silkworm feeds on the mulberry leaves. The larva of a silkworm gives out silk, which is cleaned in hot water and spun into yarn. The silk clothes are made of this yarn.









Synthetic fibre: These fibres are man - made fibres. These are also called artificial fibres. These fibres are made in factories. Rayon, nylon, polyester and terylene are synthetic fibres.







Besides these, we also use leather and fur for clothes. We get them from animals. We make jackets, belts, shoes and purses with them.

There are many people who help us in the making of our clothes. A weaver weaves the thread into clothes. The dyer dyes the clothes. The tailor stitches them for us. The washerman washes and irons when they become dirty.









Care for clothes: We must take care of our clothes properly. We should get them washed and ironed when they get dirty. We should keep them properly in the cupboard.



We should wear clean clothes always.
