





**Temple:** Hindus pray to God in temples. They have idols of Gods and Goddesses there. They call God by many names as Krishna, Rama, Shiva, Durga, Lakshmi, etc. The Pujari looks after a temple. Their holy books are the Vedas, the Bhagavad Gita, the Ramayana and the Mahabharata.

Gurudwara: Sikhs worship their Gurus in a gurudwara. They sing hymns, called Gurubani. Their holy book is the Guru Granth Sahib. They call their God by the name of Waheguru. The priest who looks after a gurudwara is called a Granthi.








Activity

Mosque: Muslims pray to God in a mosque. Their prayer is called Namaz. They do not have any idol in a mosque. Their holy book is called Koran. They call God by the name of Allah. The Muslim priest is called Maulvi.




Activity
